



We're thrilled to announce that you can now adopt a musky that's released from the Spooner Hatchery into the Chippewa Flowage. During the years following the release, the Dept. of Natural Resources (DNR) fish management teams will periodically check the Chippewa Flowage fish populations. They'll identify the muskies by scanning their PIT tags\*, record their vitals and release the fish. These results will be posted to our website annually every February when you can check to see if your fish was recaptured. We'll notify you when the results are posted.
